Being the regulatory authority of Higher Education in India, UGC has constantly been emphasising on the implementation of guidelines received from MHRD and as a part of it CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) has been introduced in the Higher Education Institutions across the country. With no exception to it, Bodoland University has also adopted the same system so that the educational system in Assam becomes more student-centric than system-centric or teacher centric. CBCS allows students to acquire more knowledge as it has flexibility for the students to study courses of their choice.

#### POST GRADUATE SECTION

Anundoram Booroah Academy has been offering P.G. courses in various subjects under Bodoland University on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). An outline of each of the courses has been given below for the greater interest of our student community.

#### 1. M.A. in English:

The course shall be of four semesters. There shall be six papers in each of the 1st and 2nd semesters whereas in 3rd semester, there shall be five papers out of which two papers are optional and the rest compulsory. In 4th semester, students shall have to appear in five papers outh of which one optional paper and one dissertation paper. There shall not be any practical paper in the course.

#### 2. M.A. in Education:

The course comprises of four semesters. There are five papers in 1st & 2nd semester. In 3rd semester, students shall have to appear in four compulsory papers out of which one is pratical paper and one optional paper. In the 4th semester there are five papers, outh of which one is optional paper and one dissertation paper.

#### 3. M.A. in Political Science:

Like M.A. in English and M.A. in Education courses, M.A. in Political science is also of four semesters. 1st & 2nd semesters contain six papers each. In the 3rd and 4th semesters, out of the five papers in each semester, two papers are optional and the rest compulsory.

#### 4. M.A. in Assamese:

The course shall be of four semesters. There shall be six papers in each of the 1st and 2nd semesters whereas in 3rd semester, there shall be five papers out of which two papers are optional and the rest compulsory. In 4th semester, students shall have to appear in five papers outh of which one optional paper and one dissertation paper. There shall not be any practical paper in the course.

#### 5. M.Sc. in Physics:

The course comprises of four semesters. The 1st semester contains six papers out of which one is of practical. In 2nd semester, there shall be six papers out of which one is a practical paper. There shall be five theory papers and a practical paper (total six papers) in 3rd semester. The 4th semester contains four theory papers and one Project paper.

#### 6. M.Sc. in Chemistry:

The course comprises of four semesters. The 1st semester contains six papers out of which one is of practical. In 2nd semester, there shall be six papers out of which one is a practical paper. There shall be five theory papers and a practical paper (total six papers) in 3rd semester. The 4th semester contains four theory papers and one Project paper.

#### 7. M. Sc. in Zoology:

The duration of the course of M.Sc. in Zoology is of two Academic years i.e. four semesters. In 1st semester, there are five papers out of which one is practical paper. In second semester, there shall be six papers out of which one is practical paper. Out of six papers in 3rd semester, there is one practical paper. In 4th semester, students shall have to select special paper as per their choices. There shall be five papers as a whole in 4th semester out of which one is practical paper and one dissertation paper.

#### 8. M.Sc. in Botany:

The duration of the course is of four semesters. In 1st semester, students shall have to study four papers out of which one is practical paper. In 2nd semester, there shall be six papers out of which one is practical paper. There are five theory papers and one practical paper in 3rd semester whereas in 4th semester, students have to select special paper as per their choice, there are four theory papers, one practical paper and one dissertation paper.

Above all, the Council, through its examination branch, also holds examinations every year of which the question papers are set by some renowned educationist of the state.



#### VISION

#### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Moral values and civil behaviour are honoured above all by all the members of the Academy.
- Utmost importance is given on maintenance of discipline. Students violating the rules and regulations of the Academy and indulging in indisciplined activity are severely dealt with and may even confiscate their admission.
- 3. Students must come to the School /College in Academy Uniform.
- 4. Students must keep their Identity Cards (issued by the authority) during Academy hours.
- 5. In case of any loss of the Identity Cards the students will have to report to the Academy authority and procure a duplicate copy on payment of Rupees 200/- (Two hundred) only.
- Any damage of the Academy property by any student will have to be adequately replaced or compensated for.
- Students are not allowed to enter the Academy campus without wearing helmet if he / she comes to the School / College by bike or scooty.
- 8. Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the Academy campus.
- 9. The Academy authority may amend the rules and regulations as and when necessary.

#### LIBRARY

Library plays a significant role in promoting knowledge. It is considered to be the storehouse of knowledge for the students. Anundoram Borooah Academy holds a spacious library with a reading room attached to it. The atmosphere of the library is a peaceful one. Students can enjoy the benefit of library services of the Academy by borrowing various text books, journals, reference books, magazines etc. from the profound collection of the Academy Library as per rules.

#### LABORATORY

Laboratory, now-a-days, is considered to be an important means of instruction in science education. Besides having a hands-on experience, laboratory equipments upholds students' ability to think subjects scientifically by conducting experiments, reviewing them closely, developing logical reasoning and responding analytical study. Anundoram Borooah Academy provides to its students well equipped laboratories for different subjects with all modern facilities. The laboratories are spacious and students can enjoy their full benefit with the help of the staff.

#### CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

For all round development of the learners the Academy offers facilities of physical exercise through active participation in games and sports and intellectual exercise like participation in seminar, interactive programmes organised from time to time.

### MOUTHPIECE (ANURANAN)

Every year Anundoram Borooah Academy brings out a mouthpiece (Anuranan) which contains stories, short stories, poems, essays and various types of articles. It reviews the educational, cultural, games and sports activities of the Academy.

#### HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. A student deemed eligible by the authority will be admitted to the hostel.
- 2. Hostel admission will be completed at the beginning of a session. Academic session will cover the period from 1st April to 31st March.
- 3. Admission Fees: 10000/- (per annum- Non refundable)
- 4. Mess Dues: 5000/- (per month)
- 5. Seat Rent: 1000/- (per month)
- 6. Boarders will not be allowed to come out of the campus before 8 a.m. and after 6.30 p.m.
- 7. Boarders will be provided with one bed, one table and one chair each. Other items including bed-sheets, pillows etc. will have to be procured by the boarders themselves. They will be provided with a tube light/CFL each. They will have to repair/replace tube light/CFL and choke whenever necessary.
- 8. Boarders are allowed to use light and fans. They cannot use electric heater, iron, mobile phone, radio, tape recorder etc..
- Boarders will be supplied with three meals a day-at morning, noon and night. Red tea
  will be supplied in the morning and evening. They will be supplied meat at dinner on
  Monday and Friday, eggs on Wednesday and Sunday and fish on Tuesday and
  Saturday.
- Entrance of females to the Boys' Hostel and males to the Girls' Hostel is strictly prohibited.
- 11. Hostel Fees will have to be paid in full for all days. There will be no concession in hostel fees and mess dues for absence of boarder at the hostel.
- 12. No petition for refund of money will be entertained in case of a boarder leaving or being ordered to leave the hostel before the end of the Matriculation Examination, Two Year H.S. course, Three Year Degree Course, Two Year PG Course.
- 13. Hostel leaving cards will be provided for the boarders. The boarders have to deposit their cards to the hostel warden when they temporarily leave the hostel. No boarder will be allowed to leave the hostel unless he / she deposits this card to the warden.
- 14. Hostel visiting cards will be provided for the visitors of the boarders. No visitor will be allowed to visit the boarders without visiting cards. The hostel warden will examine the card prior to giving permission to visit the boarder.
- 15. Smoking or drinking alcoholic beverages in the hostel is strictly prohibited.
- Decision of the authority of the Academy will be final and binding in all matters.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP**

The Academy provides facilities of various Pre-Matric and Post Matric Scholarship schemes for students of classes VI to Post Graduate. The Minority Scholarships belong to students of Muslim, Christian, Buddhist, Sikh communities etc. under the office of Char Area Development, Govt. of Assam, Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC), Most Other Backward Classes (MOBC) under the office of Integrated Tribal Development Project (ITDP), Govt. of Assam, National Merit Scholarship under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Dr. Ambedkar Foundation Merit Award for meritorious SC students under Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (after passing out H.S. Final Exam.), Govt. of India and BPL Meritorious Scholarship sanctioned by the Govt. of Assam from time to time.

Points to be considered when applying for Pre-and Post-Matric Scholarship

- Students of Minority community are eligible to apply for the scholarship (Fresh & Renewal) if they secure minimum 50% marks in the last Final Examination.
- Students are eligible to apply for the National Merit Scholarships if they secure 80% or above in the last H.S. Final Examination. To get renewal award students have to secure minimum 60% CGPA in their last UG semester exam.
- 3. BPL Meritorious Scholarships are meant for the students who have secured minimum 80% marks in the last H.S.L.C. Examination.
- Only the meritorious students belonging to SC category securing minimum 80% in the last H.S. Final Examination can apply for Dr. Ambedkar Merit Award.

In addition to the above facilities, the Academy observes keenly the chances of other scholarship facilities provided by Rastriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi, for the students having Sanskrit as one of the subjects in the last H.S.L.C. Examination securing 60% and above, Ajmal Foundation Scholarships, Hojai, Moulana Azad Memorial Scholarships, Govt. of India. In all kinds of scholarship systems students have to apply online and the Academy authority will inform the students regarding the time of applying after the consideration of Govt. notification.
